

2010 Election of Officers, Executive Committee Members, and Delegates

On February 15, the TAUP office sent you a flyer asking for nominations for candidates to run for office as Officers, Executive Committee Members and Delegates. The 2010 TAUP Nominating Committee also worked hard seeking members to run for these positions. As of the deadline for nominations, one person came forward to stand for election for each position.

Article I of the TAUP Bylaws prescribes the union's election procedures. Section 3 (Ballot and Voting), Paragraph (b) states:

For officers and delegates, if there are only as many candidates as there are open positions, the mail ballot will be foregone and the candidates will be considered elected. For Executive Committee members, if there are only as many nominees as there are open positions, and if all open positions are for full three-year terms, the mail ballot procedure will be foregone and the nominees will be considered elected.

Since the current election process meets the above conditions, there will be no balloting this year.

1. Officers: each for a term of 1 year, from May 1, 2010, to April 30, 2011.
