AT&T Wireless Discounts for TAUP Members

Dues-paying TAUP members are eligible for a [discount of 15% on AT&T](#) wireless services*. You are offered the AT&T discount, as well as other [AFT+ Member Benefits](#) or [UnionPlus](#) benefits because of your union membership. Bargaining unit members who wish to have these benefits can do so by joining TAUP.

By using the discount, TAUP members can save 15% off regular wireless service costs including phone and data plans. In addition, members can receive other savings on cell phones and accessories. Based on a \$39.99 monthly plan, families typically save \$71.88 a year with the UnionPlus AT&T Wireless Discount, based on 15% savings. Higher minute plans save even more. The discounts include the new iPhone 4 and other smartphones offered by AT&T. These savings can go some way toward offsetting your dues. The discounts cover new and existing AT&T customers.

You will be asked to fax proof of union membership if you call AT&T customer service to purchase or change your existing wireless service. The AFT membership card that was sent to TAUP dues-payers in the spring contains all the information you need to show proof. If you don't have your AFT membership card, you can call (215-763-2287 or 1-7641) or email (taupaft@aol.com) the TAUP office for help.

In addition, using these benefits supports union workers and their families. AT&T is the only wireless company that is completely unionized. Some 40,000 AT&T Mobility employees are represented by the Communications Workers of America (CWA).

** Credit approval and new two-year service agreement required. Additional lines for family plans, unlimited plans and Unity Plans or plans combining land and wireless are not eligible. Other conditions and restrictions apply.*
