**Unemployment Compensation Workshop for Adjuncts, Thursday,
April 27, 5-6 pm**

In January, the Labor Department updated its Unemployment Compensation guidelines, and adjuncts who may have had trouble filing in the past may find they can now apply and receive benefits.

The United Academics of Philadelphia, located near Temple, will be holding an Unemployment Compensation Workshop for faculty who are considering applying. The workshop can help you to understand if you are eligible, what language to use in your application to avoid raising red flags, and more.
